**Birak**

December, January.

When the days are long and the  
streams are dry.

**Bunuru**

February, March.

When the wind slows and the  
days are warm and dry.

**Djeran**

April, May

When rain returns, the days  
grow shorter and the nights  
begin to chill.

**Makuru**

June, July.

When the rain is stronger and the  
streams flow.

**Djilba**

August, September.

When the rivers are strong and  
the storms blow in.

**Kambarang**

October, November.

When the days grow longer and  
the streams run clear

**Birak**

December, January.

When the days are long and the  
streams are dry.
