English	Spelling Focus Use knowledge of letter sound relationships to spell common words accurately Reading Focus Use phonic and word knowledge to fluently read more complex words Identifies literal/implied meaning in texts Selects information, ideas and events that connect them with self and other texts Writing Correctly punctuating sentences i.e. capital letters and full stops Narratives/stories Complex text Persuasive text structures
Mathematics	In Mathematics our students will be engaging in Recall multiplication facts of 2, 5, 10 Revise 4-digit number names and numerals Recognise, model, represent and order numbers to at least 10 000 Multiplication/division relationship Measure, order and compare objects using familiar metric units of length, mass and capacity Probability
Visual Arts	In Visual Arts our students will explore: • Line • Working with warm and cool colours in a variety of mediums
Health	In Health this term our focus will be on personal and social skills to interact respectfully with others. Topics will include health messages, being sun smart, asking for permission, dealing with rejection and setting and respecting boundaries.
Physical Education	For the first four weeks of term, the focus will be on preparing for the Faction Athletics Carnival. Students will be given opportunities to set new PBs as well as show team-work through the team games. Selected students will then be asked to train for the Interschool Carnival in week 7. For the remainder of term, students will focus on Sofcrosse and Cricket skills. ie: throwing/catching, striking, throwing/catching with extension (sofcrosse).

Music	This term in Music students will continue to explore the elements of music and develop musicianship skills through songs from a variety of cultures, styles and eras; singing games; theory games; movement and dance; body percussion and playing classroom instruments, with a focus on ukulele and electronic keyboards. They will learn to identify instruments of the orchestra and instrument families.
