Description of services

- i) **Before School Care Program (starts at 6:30am)**; children will be involved in various play-based educational activities that help them transition for the school day ahead. Healthy breakfast will be supplied.
- ii) **After School Care Program (closes at 6pm)**; trained staff will provide educational play-based and age-appropriate experiences for all the children with a strong focus on individuality and inclusivity. Healthy afternoon tea and late snacks will be provided.
- iii) **Vacation Care Program (7am – 5:30pm)**; the program during school holidays will offer educational play-based and age-appropriate experiences for all the children with a strong focus on individuality and inclusivity. Healthy breakfast, morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea and late snacks will be provided.
- iv) **Pupil Free Day Care Program (7am – 5:30pm)**; the program on pupil free days will offer educational play-based and age-appropriate experiences for all the children with a strong focus on individuality and inclusivity. Healthy breakfast, morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea and late snacks will be provided.

Planned and free play activities will ensure children have plenty of choice. The focus will be on nature-based education within a culturally and ability inclusive environment. There will be structured, educational experiences available, including special themed days or weeks. Children will have access to various activities, such as art and craft, cooking, science, construction zones, drama and dress up play, board games, quiet reading corners, environmental and sustainability activities – like veggie gardens, music and dance, group games, sports, outdoors and playground play. Staff will help provide creative and engaging experiences for all children by delivering fun, educational activities that develop life skills.
